SHOWCASE RULES:

- 1. In order to submit an act, each agency or individual act must have been a member in good standing for at least two years.
- 2. An act may showcase for two consecutive years, and then must lay off one year.
- 3. Each talent agency or individual act must have a room at the convention hotel
- 4. Associates that are eligible may submit only one act. A maximum of 12 acts will be selected. **THE FOLLOWING IS NEW FOR 2016**–If more than 12 eligible acts are submitted by the deadline, associates with five or more consecutive years as members will receive preference in showcase selection. Each act will be given a 20 minute time slot.
- 5. Acts must be submitted by November 10th. A lineup will be mailed/emailed by December 1.
- 6. Associate in charge of showcase will make the lineup with new or unknown acts going early or late in the lineup. Special needs will be considered with advance notice
- 7. Ashowcase hours will be approximately 8:30 P.M. to 10:00 P.M. Friday night and 2:00 P.M. to 5:00 P.M. Saturday of the annual convention.
- 8. Introductions will not count as part of the 20 minutes if done by the NAFM MC.
- 9. The Nebraska Association of Fair Managers will be responsible for selecting the MC's for the showcase

10. NO LIVE SHOWCASING WILL BE PERMITTED IN CONVENTION HOTEL ROOMS

- 11. The NAFM shall be responsible for providing one or more of the following:
 - A. A room or other suitable facility in which to exhibit the showcase.
 - B. Suitable Stage, Sound Equipment, Power, and Lighting
 - C. Dressing Room(s)
- 12. Any showcase act or sponsoring agency not adhering to these rules shall be subject to sanctions imposed by the Board of Directors of the NAFM after notice and a hearing.
